







2025 Ford Expedition SSV Fact Sheet

Ford, home of America's best-selling police vehicle lineup¹, is announcing the all-new **2025 Ford Expedition® SSV**. It is designed to support law enforcement, fire departments, and other government agencies with rugged versatility, cutting-edge technology, and robust capability to tow, carry personnel, and haul their gear helping deliver public service 24/7.

Highlights and Features:

- Standard **24-inch panoramic display** replaces the traditional gauge cluster, placing vital information at eye level.
- The new **Ford Split Gate** makes 2025 Expedition® SUV the only vehicle in its class that offers a Split Gate feature². Officers can lift three-quarters of the liftgate for quick access or fold down the tailgate to use as a stable platform capable of supporting up to 500 pounds, ideal for organizing gear at a moment's notice.
- Expedition SSV is available as a two-row configuration with cloth seating surfaces, vinyl
 floors, and an array of power points for all areas of the vehicle, or as Expedition Max
 SSV with three rows of seating with third Row 60/40 PowerFold® with Power Recline
 to help accommodate personnel and equipment as required.
- The **Ford Digital Experience** includes voice-activated systems like Google Assistant or Alexa Built-in allow for hands-free control over in-vehicle functions, navigation, and communications³.
- Security and convenience features include Police Accessory Independent Timed-Release Output (PAITRO) to help prevent unauthorized access to the cargo area, and Dark Car mode⁴ to remain discrete during stakeouts.
- The Expedition SSV powertrain is standard with a 3.5-liter EcoBoost® V6 engine which develops 400 horsepower and 480 lb.-ft. of torque⁵. It also comes standard as with 4x4 with a **new two-speed transfer case with Touch on Demand and 4-Auto.**
- Expedition SSV delivers up to a 7,000-pound towing capacity⁶ without a load-leveling bar, and a **9,600-pound maximum towing capacity**⁷ with a load-leveling bar.
- Expedition SSV includes Pro Trailer Hitch Assist™ and Pro Trailer Backup Assist™, BLIS® with Cross-Traffic Alert, and BLIS® with Trailer Coverage to help with hitching, backing, and situational awareness for mounted units and municipal uses⁸.
- Comes standard with an 18-inch aluminum wheel with the option for a black police wheel with the silver/gray center cap
- Latest electrical architecture allows for extensive over-the-air updates⁹, keeping units in the field up to date without downtime at the dealership.
- **Assembled in America**: The 2025 Ford Expedition SSV is assembled with pride at Ford's **Kentucky Truck Plant**¹².

A special piece of news is that Expedition is the first product from Ford to offer two new driver assistance enhancements - Pre-Collision Assist® with Automatic Emergency Braking 2.2, and Intersection Assist 2.2. PCA with AEB 2.2 includes the capability to detect pending collision from oncoming traffic and applies the brakes to reduce the severity of an impact¹³. Intersection Assist 2.0 includes a similar feature to help detect a potential collision with an oncoming vehicle while the driver is attempting to turn left. If Intersection Assist detects such a risk from a vehicle, bicycle, motorcycle, or pedestrian, Expedition SSV will alert the driver and can apply the brakes if needed¹⁴.

The broad Ford first responder lineup includes the only pursuit-rated AWD hybrid police utility, the 2025 Police Interceptor® Utility, the first-ever pursuit-rated pickup – 2025 F-150® Police Responder® Pickup, and the 2025 F-150® Lightning Pro® SSV. Ford police vehicles are specialized to meet the rigors of police duty and the wide variety of public service needs.
